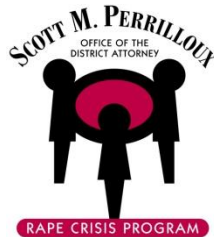
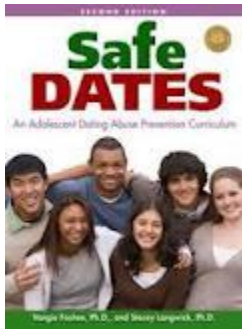


Tri-Parish Rape Crisis Program Community Education



All community education is provided by a Licensed Professional Counselor at no cost to the school.



Safe Dates is a school-based program designed to stop or prevent the initiation of psychological, physical, and sexual abuse on dates or between individuals involved in a dating relationship. Intended for male and female middle- and high-school students 12 to 18 years of age, the Safe Dates program can stand alone or easily fit within a health education, family, or general life skills curriculum. Each topic can be stand-alone or included in a series.
